Child Safety

It is a pleasure to announce the launch of the new Child Safe Program based on the NSW government child safe standards.

When you open the school's website you

will find a link to the new Child Safe Program which introduces the six public facing documents that are core to a transparent Child Safe Program.

In addition to these documents, you will also find the following:

- General Enquiries - about the Child Safe Program can be sought by contacting your school's Child Safe Advocates (Ms Charmony Dias and Mrs Lyndal Hay)
- Reporting Child Safe Incidents/Concerns - for reporting professional misconduct and reportable conduct incidents (Child Safe Adult Code of Conduct and Professional Boundaries of Staff)
- Anonymous Child Protection Mechanism - for anonymous reporting to the NSW Office of Children's Guardian concerning child safe incidents follow the link provided within the document called Complaints Management (one of the six public facing documents)
- These documents and options are readily available to the whole school
