Check your Child's Tutor WWCC

Does your child receive after school tutoring or attend after school programs? If so, you are entitled to ask the tutor to

provide a Working With Children Check application or clearance number. Once you have requested a number you can then verify that number online. Verifying a clearance online is quick and easy, and ensures that a Working With Children Check clearance is current.

The Working With Children Check (WWCC) is a requirement for anyone who works or volunteers in child-related work in NSW. It involves a National Police Check (criminal history record check) and a review of reportable workplace misconduct. The outcome of a check is either a clearance to work with children or a bar against working with children.
